Resolution Title: Funding Allocations for the 2024-29 QNIHS Fund

WHEREAS the Government of Canada announced \$82 million over 10 years, and \$6 million a year ongoing, for the creation of a permanent Inuit Health Survey in 2018; and,

WHEREAS the ITK BoD passed a resolution in June 2020 to fund years 3 to 6 of Qanuippitaa? Funds as 15% to ITK, 5% for an urban survey, and 80% to be allocated using the December 2019 Board approved general regional allocation funding formula; and,

WHEREAS over fiscal years 2024-25 and 2025-26 there is \$20,954,298 in funding to allocate for development and delivery of the Qanuippitaa? National Inuit Health Survey; and,

WHEREAS the National Inuit Committee on Health brought forward two options of funding allocation to the ITK BoD to follow the general regional allocation funding formula or a new funding formula of 45% base and 55% per capita;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the funding allocation for fiscal years 2024-25 to 2025-26 for the QNIHS are \$3,143,145 to ITK for overall administration and national activities, \$1,047,715 to the Ottawa QNIHS, as well as following the general funding formula as follows:

- ☐ \$2,179,247 to the Inuvialuit Regional Corporation;
- ☐ \$8,398,482 to Nunavut Tunngavik Inc.;
- ☐ \$4,190,860 to the Nunavik Regional Board of Health and Social Services;
- ☐ \$1,994,849 to the Nunatsiavut Government.
