Resolution Title: Funding Allocations for the QNIHS in 2026/27 and 2027/28

WHEREAS the Government of Canada announced \$82 million over 10 years, and \$6 million a year ongoing, for the creation of a permanent Inuit Health Survey in 2018; and,

WHEREAS the ITK BoD passed a resolution in September 2023 to fund years 7 and 8 of Qanuippitaa? as 15% to ITK, 5% for an urban survey, and 80% to be allocated using the December 2019 Board approved general regional allocation funding formula; and,

WHEREAS over fiscal years 2026/27 and 2027/28 there is \$11,982,300 in funding to allocate for development and delivery of the Qanuippitaa? National Inuit Health Survey; and,

WHEREAS the National Inuit Committee on Health recommends to the ITK BoD to continue to follow the general regional allocation funding formula, with 15% to ITK, 5% for an urban pilot survey in the National Capital Region, and 80% to the four regions, which is further allocated using the general funding formula of 35% base and 65% per-capita;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the funding allocation for fiscal years 2026/27 and 2027/28 for the QNIHS are \$1,797,345 to ITK for overall administration and national activities, \$599,115 to the Ottawa QNIHS, as well as following the general funding formula as follows:

- \$1,246,159 to the Inuvialuit Regional Corporation;
- \$4,802,506 to Nunavut Tunngavik Inc.;
- \$2,396,460 to the Nunavik Regional Board of Health and Social Services;
- \$1,140,715 to the Nunatsiavut Government.
