Resolution Title: Funding Allocations for the 2026-2031 Tuberculosis Elimination Fund

WHEREAS The Federal Government announced \$27 million over five years, starting in 2026-2027 for Tuberculosis Elimination (TBE) work in Inuit communities; and,

WHEREAS Inuit and the Government of Canada remain committed to eliminating tuberculosis in Inuit Nunangat by 2030; and,

WHEREAS the ITK Board of Directors resolution B19-05-08 for tuberculosis elimination applied a modified General Regional Allocation Funding Formula of 15% base, 25% per capita, and 60% indicator of raw 5-year total case proportion.

WHEREAS the ITK Board of Directors resolution B23-07-XX for tuberculosis elimination followed the same modified General Regional Allocation Funding Formula of 15% base, 25% per capita, and 60% indicator of raw 5-year total case proportion.

WHEREAS the regional status for current active and latent tuberculosis disease has shifted and tuberculosis elimination program costs have increased due to inflation.

WHEREAS two options for the tuberculosis elimination regional allocations have been considered.

WHEREAS the National Inuit Committee on Health recommends to the ITK BoD to follow option one to modify the general regional allocation funding formula, with 5% to ITK and 95% to the four regions, which is further allocated as a modified general funding formula of 25% base, 15% per capita, and 60% indicator of 10-year total case proportion.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the funding allocation for fiscal year 2026/27 to 2030/31 for tuberculosis elimination are \$1.35 million for ITK for overall administration and national activities, as well following the modified general funding formula as follows:

- \$1,856,316 to the Inuvialuit Regional Corporation;
- \$11,666,851 to Nunavut Tunngavik Inc.;
- \$9,033,058 to the Nunavik Regional Board of Health and Social Services;
- \$3,093,775 to the Nunatsiavut Government.
