Resolution Title: Environment and Wildlife: Indigenous Partnerships for Nature Funding

WHEREAS *A Force of Nature: Canada's Strategy to Protect Nature*, announced a renewed commitment to protecting nature with an investment of 3.8B over 5 years; and,

WHEREAS Environment and Climate Change Canada consolidated four programs that previously supported Inuit-led projects focused on conservation, climate solutions, species at risk, and migratory birds into a single program called the Indigenous Partnerships for Nature (IPN); and,

WHEREAS an Inuit-specific allocation of \$33,323,623 (~\$33M) over 5 years from 2026-27 to 2030-31 is available through the new IPN program; and,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the funding of \$33,323,623 over 5 years is allocated using the general regional allocation funding formula, after providing funding to Inuit Tapiriit Kanatami (ITK) and the Inuit Circumpolar Council-Canada (ICC-C), as follows:

- \$3,894,946 to the Inuvialuit Regional Corporation;
- \$15,010,523 to Nunavut Tunngavik Inc.;
- \$7,490,281 to Makivvik;
- \$3,565,374 to the Nunatsiavut Government;
- \$2,500,000 to ITK;
- \$862,500 to ICC-Canada.
